MRB Group provided master planning and design services for a joint municipal facility located in the Village of Scottsville. With consideration given to maximizing utilization of space to accommodate both municipalities' operational needs, the challenge to creatively incorporate existing structures into newly renovated space were met by MRB Group's collaborative team of site developers, architects and interior space designers.

The phased project relocated the Fire Department to a newly constructed fire Hall, and then upgraded the existing building to accommodate new Town/Village offices and a Senior Center for the community.

MRB Group's design altered the entire interior of the building to include a new layout of the existing space and an expansion into the vacated area previously occupied by the Fire Department. The building, at approximately 14,200 square feet, now houses:

- senior center with a kitchen
- professional, consolidated public records storage
- office space for Town personnel, Village officials, the County Sheriff, Judge and Court Clerk
- board room/conference room
- break room
- work room
- restroom

In addition to the interior renovations, MRB Group designed exterior modifications to the front of the building and rear access to change the building's appearance from a "garage look" to an attractive facade and nice focal point for the community.
